PRESIDENT-ELECT

Kelly Mayes, CPA

Kelly has 17 years of public accounting experience and has been with BDO for four years. Kelly serves as one of the office's lead managers with municipal governments and is the office's subject matter expert for IT general controls and their impact on the internal control structure.
